

## SCENARIO NO. 1

You are the newly appointed Captain over Criminal Investigations Division. Your division oversees criminal investigations, Internal Affairs, Property and Evidence, and Records.

You have been placed in this position because the chief has concerns that detectives are not clearing cases efficiently or effectively. The Chief has noted that CID had an annual clearance rate of 15% over all Part 1 Crimes, significantly lower than in prior years. Prior to your arrival to CID, the chief placed 2 more officers into CID, bringing your total number of detective personnel to 6. She has asked you to conduct an audit to understand why the clearance rate has declined over the past year and wants you to report your findings to her.

**Additional:** A review in CAD/RMS indicates that in the last 12 months, CID has been assigned to investigate 200 crimes. 140 of these crimes are property crimes (burglaries, thefts, burglary from vehicle, and vehicle thefts). 60 crimes are violent crimes (sexual assaults, robberies, and aggravated assaults).
